## Covid-19 secure band rehearsals at Poynton Methodist Church

### Instructions for parents / guardians and band members

#### Before attending a rehearsal

If the member of PYBB has had a positive COVID-19 test within the last 2 weeks, or if the band member has experienced any of the following symptoms within the last week:

- A temperature above 37.8°C
- A dry persistent cough that has developed during the week
- A loss of taste or smell (anosmia)

Or if any member of your household has presented any of the above symptoms within the last 2 weeks:

He / She **must not** attend the band rehearsal and should seek medical advice either by contacting their GP or calling 111 to seek advice.

All band members in school year 7 and above (secondary school age) are asked to take a twice weekly Lateral Flow test.

A short questionnaire will be sent out on the day of the rehearsal. Please take a couple of minutes to complete and return.

Please do not feel under any pressure for the band member to attend a rehearsal, if you don't feel comfortable doing so.

Band members must book a place at the rehearsal in advance. Attendance will be limited to a maximum of 15 players. The first 15 band members to book will be allowed to attend. Instructions on how to book will be sent out on the day of the rehearsal via email.

Ensure that, before attending the rehearsal, the band member has printed any music which has been sent out via a downloadable link.

The following is a checklist of essential items to be brought to every rehearsal:

- Instrument (we recommend regular cleaning, once every 2 weeks minimum)
- Music Stand
- Large towel (and waterproof bag)
- Hand sanitiser
- Face covering
- Bell covering
- Music

If possible, please attach name labels.

**Poynton Youth Brass Band reserves the right to refuse admission to any band member who has not brought all of the above items to a rehearsal.**

## Arrival at the rehearsal

Parents are asked to arrive and park in the Poynton Civic Centre Car Park no later than 7.15pm.

On arrival to the car park, band members to remain in parent's / guardian's vehicle until invited into the rehearsal venue by a band representative.

Where possible, only one parent / guardian to bring the band member to the rehearsal.

Band members are asked to arrive in the car park at least 15 minutes before the start of the rehearsal. Rehearsals start at 7.30pm, please arrive in the car park by 7.15pm.

In case a band member is refused admittance, parent's / guardians are asked to stay in their vehicles, and to remain until advised to leave by a band representative.

Before entering the building, band members must sanitise their hands. Sanitiser will be made available at the hall entrance.

Face coverings must be worn upon arrival at the venue and should only be removed when playing. This is voluntary for children of primary school age.

## During the rehearsal

Social interaction will be limited before, during and after rehearsals.

The two-metre social distancing rule will be enforced at all times.

Chairs will be spaced two metres apart.

Band members must stay in their seats until give permission to move.

Band members must provide their own music stands.

Band members must place their own large towel on the floor, as instructed by a band representative.

Any discharge of condensate (water) from the instrument must be made entirely into the towel.

Bell coverings must be used during the rehearsal to reduce aerosol transmission.

Band members must not share any equipment.

No food or drink, except water, to be brought to a rehearsal.

Attendance will be limited to a maximum of 15 players.

In the event of a band member becoming ill during a rehearsal, he/she must inform the adult(s) present immediately. The band member will be removed to a secure area and the parent/guardian will be informed to collect immediately.

## Packing Away After Rehearsal

Band members must place their towel into their waterproof bag, then sanitise their hands.

Band members must pack away their own cases and bags as quickly as possible, respecting social distancing.

## Departure after rehearsal

All band members will wear face coverings, voluntary for children of primary school age.

Social distancing rules will be observed.

Towels must be taken home in the waterproof bag and laundered appropriately.

Band members will wait outside, under supervision, for their transport home.

Parents / Guardians are asked to either remain in their vehicles or wait outside the church entrance.

Parents/ Guardians are asked to arrive promptly at 8.30pm.

## If some develops Covid-19 symptoms following a rehearsal

In the eventuality of a band member developing Covid-19 following a rehearsal, Track and Trace must be contacted giving the date and address of the rehearsal.
